
LOCATION AND BUILDING:


RULES & REGULATIONS FOR ADMISSION TO B.Ed. COURSE

For session 2024-25 admission will be through Joint B.Ed. Entrance test conducted by PU, Chandigarh.

CERTIFICATES TO BE ATTACHED

Every student seeking admission to the B.Ed. course shall be required to attach the attested copies of following documents and original certificates will have to be produced at the time of admission

- 1. A character certificate from the last attended institution, in case of the teacher from head of the institution in which He/She worked last.
- 2. Date of Birth certificate and Aadhar Card of Candidate and his/her parents.
- 3. Domicile certificate.
- 4. Degree of (B.A, B.Sc, B.Com, Part I, II & III, M.A, M.Sc, M.Com, B.E and any other) along with detail marks certificate
- 5. Certificate for Special claims: Candidates seeking admission on the basis of special claim like Border Area, Sports, Freedom fighter, Disabled, Defence, Para Military, Riotaffected, Widow /Divorced, Ex-Servicemen themselves and Andeman/ Nicobar. Such



- 6. Application should be submitted regarding not to join any other Institution or Part Time Job during the tenure of the B.Ed Course.
- 7. In case candidate who have passed their 10" & 12" from school situated in rural area of Punjab they will have to submit a certificate issued by Head/ Principal of the school and should be counter signed by District Education officer for schools affiliated to state board and counter signed by Sarpanch of the village for CBSE/ICSE schools

MIGRATION RULES

Candidates from Universities other than Panjab university will have to submit the Migration Certificate in original and original detailed marks card of last class passed within 30 days from the date of enrolment failing which they will have to pay Rs. 1000/-as Late fee for one week for last date, after one week fine Rs 2000, as per the rules and instructions of Panjabi University, Chandigarh.

MODE OF PAYMENT OF COLLEGE DUES (FEES)

- ★ Fee Structure for Session 2024-25 will be announced at the time of counseling.
- * The dates of payment of dues will be notified by the Principal from time to time according to the Panjab University, Chandigarh schedule.

IMPORTANT NOTE

- 1. Fees once paid shall not be refunded.
- 2. The candidate who fails to deposit his/her fees and thus misses his chance for admission will have no claim for admission on subsequent dates.
- 3. If any student does not attend the college within a week of the opening day, as announced by the College, his admission will stand cancelled.
- 4. Students admitted under SC/ST category will have to submit their original SC/ST certificate at the time of admission or else their admission will stand cancelled.
- 5. Supplementary admission will be made as per the decision of the Centralized Admission Committee.
- 6. All dues must be cleared before final examinations.

LEAVE RULES

- 1. Leave for absence from the college should be applied personally by a student on the prescribed form available from the college office.
- 2. Leave will be sanctioned by the Principal on the recommendation of the tutor of the student and must be got sanctioned before it is availed of. In case of illness the application should be supported by a medical certificate

EXAMINATIONS/ATTENDANCE

- 1. Examinations will be held as per Panjab University schedule semester wise.
- 2. Monthly tests in all the subjects will be mandatory for B.Ed. class.
- 3. At least 80% attendance will essential to appear in the examination. Special reward will be given to those with 100% attendance.
- 4. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against students who absent themselves from the Examination or Monthly tests, Fine will also be imposed on defaulters.

UNIFORM

Wearing of the College uniform is compulsory during College hours and at the College functions. Fine will be imposed i.e Rs.50/- per day for uniform defaulters.

FOR GIRLS-

Uniform consists of all over white suit with Navy Blue dupatta and day of wearing uniform is Monday, Wednesday and Friday. In winters the color of cardigan for girls is Navy Blue.

FOR BOYS-

Uniform consists of White Shirt and Navy Blue Pent and Navy Blue Turban (optional) and day of wearing uniform is Monday, Wednesday and Friday. In winters the color of cardigan for boys is Navy Blue.

IMPORTANT RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. At the time of admission each student is issued a library-cum- identity card. Always keep this card in purse. It can be checked any time.
- 2. The college will start at 9 A.M. All students should be punctual. Students who are coming from far off places should make their own arrangements. No excuse will be entertained for their coming late to the college.
- 3. Students will not be allowed to miss the classes while in the campus. Strict action shall

be taken against the defaulters.

- 4. Leave must be sanctioned from college authorities in advance upto 2 days from the Tutor and more than upto 2 days from Principal.
- 5. Medical leave will be granted by the Principal. The leave application should be supported by a valid medical certificate and recommended by your tutor
- 6. Students are advised to see the notice board dally. No excuse will be entertained a student fails to read any important notice. The consequences of this neglect will rest upon the student. Students are not allowed to remove any notice from the notion board, which has been put up by the college. Such students if identified will be fined or liable to disciplinary action.
- 7. Students are advised to actively participate in all activities of the college, so their teachers can help them in identifying their talents. Always keep perfect discipline and decorum

GENERAL RULES

- 1. The college is pledged to strict vegetarianism. Taking of meat, eggs, fish or any non-vegetarian preparation thereof is strictly prohibited in the college campus.
- 2. The college enforces simplicity in dress. The wearing of all kinds of gold and diamond ornaments is also discouraged.
- 3. A student who wishes to withdraw from the college can do so by sending an application addressed to the Principal duly signed by the guardian.
- 4. Guardians and parents will please note that visitors are not allowed to see the students during college hours.
- 5. The visiting hours for general public to meet the Principal are from 12.00 noon to 1.30pm
- 6. Any Student who misbehaves or creates nuisance in the college will be fined heavily

CODE OF CONDUCT

Every Prospective Teacher should:

- 1. Make it a habit to see the college notice board daily.
- 2. Be regular and punctual to class.
- 3. Practice and promote integrity, sincerity and self discipline at all times.
- 4. Be brief in talk whether on phone or in person.
- Use his time fruitfully and in a planned way to complete the various tasks and go college library during free period.
- 6. Promote the concept of 'dignity of labour and help in keeping the college premises neat and clean

7. Use college property with care and park your vehicles at the proper place only.

No Prospective Teacher will:

- 1. Put up or remove any notice from notice board without permission of the Principal.
- 2. Organize any meetings or programmes or collect money within the college premises without the prior permission of the Principal.
- 3. Gossip in the hall or loiter in college lawns during free periods.
- 4. Meet visitors during college hours without permission.
- 5. Take leave unless absolutely necessary and that too without permission from the Principal. In any emergency, the leave letter should be submitted immediately after leave.

LIBRARY AND READING ROOM

The college has a well equipped digital library with INFLIBNET online access and reading room with a wide variety of books on different subjects which provide ample opportunity to the students for study, self education and general knowledge. It remains open during college hours. The college subscribes to a large number of Indian and foreign journals and periodicals in education.

LIBRARY RULES

- 1. Two books are issued to a student for a period of 14 days only.
- 2. The books will be re-issued if they are not in demand by other students.
- 3. A fine of Rs. 5/- per day per volume is charged for the book returned after the due date.
- 4. Books will be re-issued for the specified period.
- 5. Reference books, text books, rare books & periodicals shall not be issued except for consultation in the Library premises.
- 6. The students are required to possess their Identity Card while inside the library and reading room.
- 7. Books issued from the Library should be kept very carefully and in no case be underlined and disfigured. If the book is already damaged in any form, it should be got checked by the issuing clerk or by the Librarian, otherwise the responsibility will be of the student.
- 8. The loss of book should be reported to Librarian before the due date, in the absence of which, fine will be charged till the information given. The borrower will be required to replace it. He/She will have to pay double the price along with his/her next college dues if the book could not replaced.
- 9. The students are expected to observe perfect silence in the reading room and not to

disturb others in any way.

10. Students should check whether all pages are intact or not before getting the books issued If pages are found missing at the time of returning, then they will be fined heavily, Inform the Librarian or Issuing clerk regarding the missing pages at the time of getting the books Issued and get the signature of Librarian along with the notification of missing pages.









WORKSHOPS


CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

To Develop all round personality of students we provide opportunity to participate in Zonal & Inter-Zonal youth festivals. Our students won many prizes at these levels.


GAMES AND SPORTS



Extension lectures by eminent persons are arranged in various areas of education. These Lecture help the students to develop insight into the subject and get latest information and knowledge about subject areas.






